

ACTION POINTS TO INCLUDE IN KENYA COUNTRY PLAN – iCCM 2014

What are our most critical priorities across thematic areas? How do they link to existing plans?

- Launch of iCCM documents with subsequent dissemination and sensitization of county teams;
- Options for financing ;
- Strengthening of supervision and performance quality assurance;
- Support county to improve forecasting and allocate resources for essential commodities;

What is achievable in the next 6 months?

- Launch of iCCM documents: this will include finding high level champions;
- Inclusion of iCCM in global fund proposal;
- Develop national scale up plan and early adopter counties;
- Define the competencies of the supervisory role for iCCM. By defining the competencies then able to develop a tool to assess the CHEW competencies, then intervene – on going coaching, training etc;
- Formation for commodity availability teams in early implementer districts (6 months);

In the next year?

- Support community dialogue around iCCM;
- Sharing of commodity availability team experience from early implementer districts;

What additional resources will we need for each priority area?

- TA for global fund concept note;
- Support to bring senior regional iCCM champion;
- County dissemination;

What are our next steps as a country to implement these next steps?

- Meeting with NCAHU Head to share symposium findings;
- Meeting with DFH to share symposium findings;
- Convene iCCM planning meeting will share immediate action and broader actions from symposium (should include in the iCCM Kenya workplan);
- TORs for consultant – currently with iCCM program officer Lydia Karimurio who will review discuss with Dr. Nyamai NCAH unit;
- Malaria Harmonization Working Group – malaria strategic plan meeting Tuesday 11th to Friday 14th March 2014;
