

## Action Points to Include in Country Plan

### What are our most critical priorities across thematic areas? How do they link to existing plans?

1. Strengthen supply chain for iCCM
2. Standardize and strengthen supervision for iCCM
3. Cost and leverage partnerships

### What is achievable in the next 6 months?

- Conduct national quantification for iCCM
- Standardize and complete supervision package, train and disseminate
- Identify existing staff for CHSS supervisors and recruit additional 88 CHSS supervisors
- Train supervisors in national supervision package (package currently finalized)
- Convene high level stakeholder meeting to build buy-in and leverage resources

### In the next year?

- Integrate community data into national HMIS and align national indicators with global recommendations
- Scale up community advocacy package through stakeholder meetings
- Explore potential for mHealth in Liberia and leveraging partnerships with phone companies for messaging
- Recognize CHVs through national health meeting
- Integrate newborn care into iCCM and strengthen newborn component of Road Map/further clarify roles of community cadres

### What additional resources will we need for each priority area?

- Technical assistance for forecasting drugs and costing the package and for developing the tools and materials for implementation of the supply chain for iCCM
- Financial support for procurement and distribution of medicines

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### **What are our next steps as a country to implement these next steps?**

- Finalize report and submit trip report to Department of Health Services, Ministry of Health and Social Welfare
- Convene country team and share highlights and next steps with community health coordination committee and the reproductive health technical committee
- Reach out to JSI Deliver and the National Supply Chain Unit to include iCCM in national quantification
